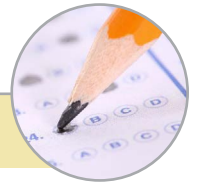

## CPLS Geology Field Camp

The CPLS Geology Field Camp is a great experience for your child if he or she is an upcoming 7th grade student or older! We will spend one day in the school lab going over the trip including what to expect, what to bring, where we will go and camper expectations. Then, we will spend the next three days in the field focused on the geology of western Kansas. Our first visit will be to Mushroom Rock State Park where we'll climb around on the various formations and talk about concretions. Then, we will take a short jaunt to Lake Kanopolis for lunch and looking for various fossil and mineral specimens including iron concretions, barite roses, iron pyrite crystals and turitella shells. From Kanopolis we will travel to our camping destination for the next two nights and perhaps spend some time exploring for fossils till the sun goes down. We'll spend the next two days in the field on private land looking for fish fossils, petrified wood, sharks teeth and mineral samples. We'll swim at Lake Scott State Park and wander through the amazing chalk formations of Monument rocks. On our way back home, we will visit Lake Wilson to have lunch, swim in the lake and collect big selenite crystals. Evenings will be spent around the campfire (weather and conditions permitting), star gazing, and maybe wandering the hills at night.

If you choose to come along with us on this field camp you'll return home with fossils of shells, hopefully teeth, and maybe even a fish fossil. In addition, you'll take home samples of the following minerals to expand your collection: pyrite, barite roses, marcasite, selenite, limonite, calcite and iron concretions that look like mace weapons from the Middle Ages!

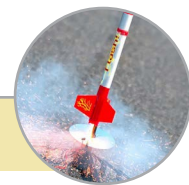
